FIDELIDADE ARTE HOSTS AN EXHIBITION BY SILVIA BÄCHLI

Curated by Bruno Marchand, the exhibition "Side Facing the Wind" will be open to the public in Lisbon between September 10 and November 26.

Lisbon, September 07, 2021 - Fidelidade Arte and Culturgest open the exhibition "*Side Facing the Wind*", by Swiss artist Silvia Bächli, on September 9. The exhibition, which is part of the Reação em Cadeia (portuguese for Chain Reaction) project and is curated by Bruno Marchand, will be open to the public until November 26 at Espaço Fidelidade Arte, in Lisbon, with free admission.

The work of Silvia Bächli (Baden, Switzerland, 1956) resembles a visual inventory of the subtle experiences of everyday life. Working almost exclusively in the field of drawing, the artist has been exploring, since the mid-1980s, a very narrow set of graphic resources - essentially stroke and colour - through which she seeks to fix impressions and sensations that we experience every day.

As the title of the exhibition - "Side Facing the Wind" - indicates, the peculiar experience of our body affected by a crosswind can be the trigger for a set of works that make visible the ineffable essence of this phenomenon. Bächli's drawings are essays: images that make approximations, necessarily incomplete and partial, to the intangible world.

The exhibition "Side Facing the Wind" is the eighth moment of the cycle Reação em Cadeia, a collaboration between Fidelidade Arte and Culturgest, which involves the participating artists in the choice of the artists who succeed them. Each year there will be interventions by three artists at Fidelidade Arte, in Lisbon, and later at Culturgest Porto, which will experience different declinations in each space, namely with the presence of different works, resulting from the adaptation of the projects to the different nature of the two galleries.

At the end of each year, a book will be published that will compile the memory of the three projects presented, with extensive documentation on their development. The Swiss artist was chosen by her predecessor, the Mexican Rodrigo Hernández, whose exhibition "Moon Foulard" constituted the seventh edition of the cycle Chain Reaction.

The cycle began in 2019 with a program that, in keeping with this logic of succession, featured the following artists:
